

ASRAM2025 Guidelines for Authors on Oral Presentation

Presentations should meet the following criteria:

Presentation Size

- All presentations must be created in, or converted to, Microsoft PowerPoint or PDF (Recommend PDF). AV can be presented in 16:9 or 4:3.

Format

- No specific template styles
- The presentation should be easily readable.
- Avoid using mixtures of type/font styles.
- Text and presentation should be in English mainly.
- The cover of the presentation should display the following information:
 - Title of the Paper
 - Name(s) of the Author(s)
 - Affiliation(s)
 - Abstract ID Number (INDICO)

Note

- Please be aware that all display materials should be prepared in advance. The authors should prepare the presentation in Microsoft PowerPoint or PDF files and upload them to the computers or laptops in the room before the session starts 10 minutes. You will be able to use your laptop only in an urgent case.
- Please also upload **1) your presentation and 2) your short bio (no format)** to a PDF file in the INDICO system after paper or extended abstract acceptance (My Conference → My Contributions → Presentation materials)
