

ASRAM2025 Guidelines for Authors on Poster Presentation

Posters should meet the following criteria:

Poster Size

- All posters should not be bigger than in portrait format and the size of A0 (1189 mm high and 841 mm wide).

Format

- No specific template styles
- The poster should be easily readable.
- Avoid using mixtures of type/font styles.
- Text and presentation should be in English mainly.
- The top of the poster should display the following information:
 - Title of the Paper
 - Name(s) of the Author(s)
 - Affiliation(s)
 - Abstract ID Number (INDICO)

Note

- Please be aware that all print and display materials should be prepared in advance by yourself. Scot tapes or Pins for mounting posters are available on-site. It is not possible to print posters at the meeting site.
- Please also upload 1) your poster and 2) your short bio (No format) to a PDF file in the INDICO system after paper or extended abstract acceptance (My Conference → My Contributions → Presentation materials)
